The district has had recent referendum success and has demonstrated their commitment to safety and security. The district is also committed to saving energy and sustainability.

In 2018, the district implemented a district-wide Energy Efficiency project. The project consisted of four measures: LED Lighting, Building Envelope Improvements, Destratification Fans, and Retro-Commissioning. The district is expecting their strategy to reduce utility expenditures will prove to be valuable in the future.
