The lighting retrofit project eliminates the existing fluorescent lights and ballasts and provides new LED tubes that bypass the ballast. The ability to retrofit the existing fixtures keeps the project costs down so there is a better simple payback. The energy savings was maximized in each space throughout the store by selecting the proper LED tubes to deliver the recommended light levels according to the Illuminating Engineering Society (IESNA).

Maurer's also received a one-time rebate from Focus on Energy, Wisconsin utilities' statewide energy efficiency and renewable resource program.
